Sui-Hang Hui's practice focuses on international arbitration and dispute resolution. He has broad experience advising on general commercial matters, including proceedings conducted under ICC, HKIAC, SIAC and UNCITRAL rules, as well as before Hong Kong courts and tribunals.

Mr. Hui previously clerked as a judicial assistant at the Court of Final Appeal, the highest appellate court in Hong Kong. In 2024, he was appointed by the Secretary for Justice of Hong Kong as a member of the Expert Advisory Group on Legal and Dispute Resolution Services and appointed by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region as a member of the Passports Appeals Board. In addition, he is a member of the Steering Committee of International Bar Association's Arb40 Subcommittee and the Hong Kong Law Society's Greater China Legal Affairs and Arbitration committees. Between 2022-24, Mr. Hui was a committee member of HK45, a young practitioner group formed under the auspices of the HKIAC.

Mr. Hui writes and speaks regularly on developments in international arbitration and has been invited as a guest lecturer by various universities, including Beijing Jiaotong University, Chinese University of Hong Kong, Peking University, Renmin University of China and Shenzhen University.
